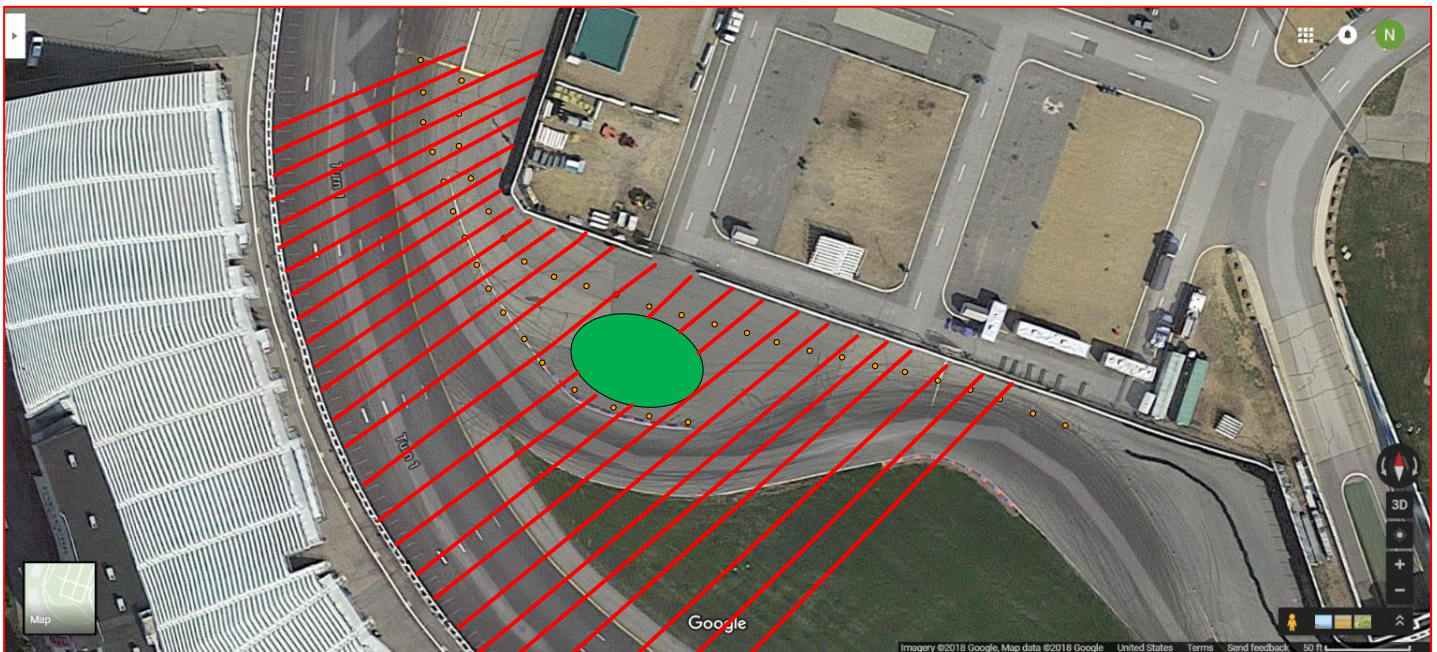
Current 2018 Rulebook:

6.2.5 Unsafe or unsportsmanlike riding may result in a penalty.

The following changes to the Loudon Road Race Series (LRRS) 2018 Rulebook are effective immediately:

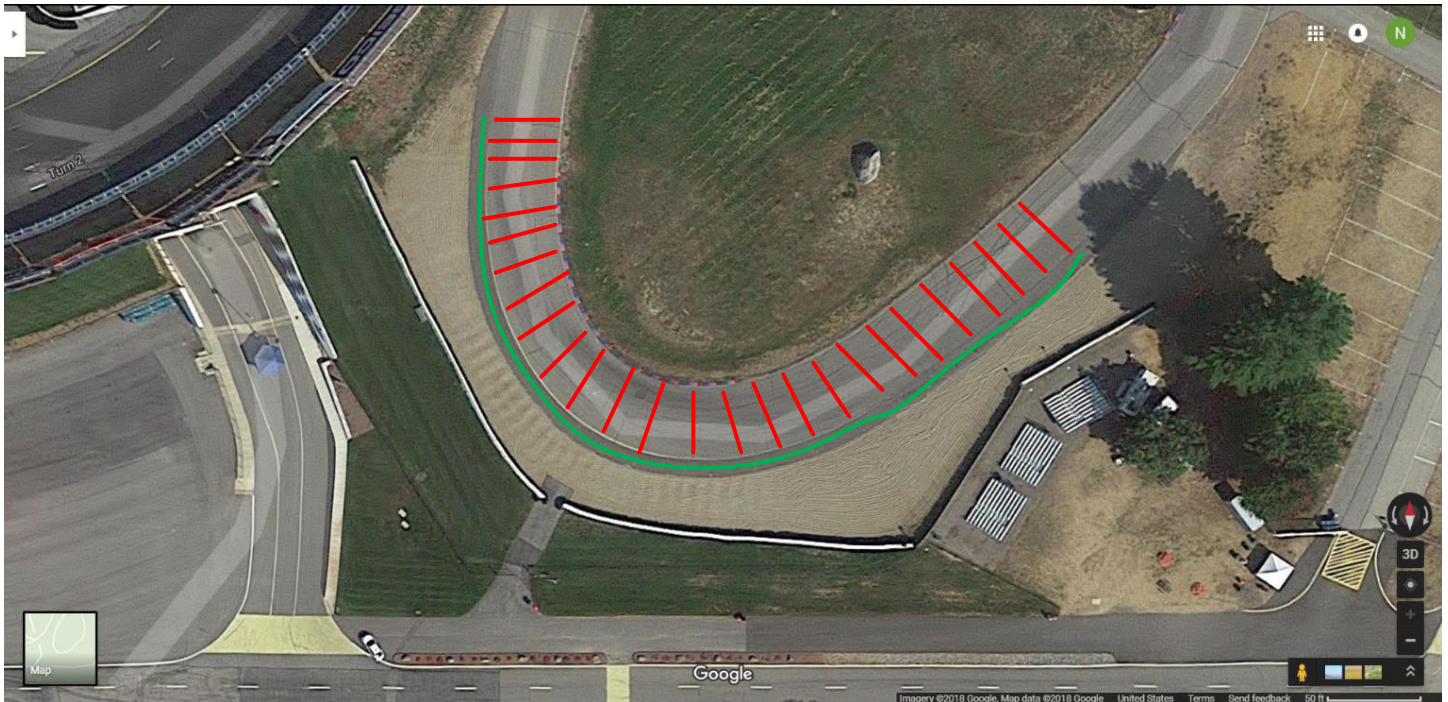
6.2.5 Unsafe or unsportsmanlike riding may result in a penalty.

6.2.5.1 Burnout Zone – the **First Place** winner of a race may perform a celebratory burnout only in the following two (2) areas of the racing surface. 1.) inside of the eyebrow curbing of Turn 1 and 2.) apron at the top of Turn 6 (“the bowl”). If a Rider is found to be performing a burnout in any other area of the race track, cold pit, hot pit, paddock, garage area or any other part of NHMS property a \$1,000 fine will be levied as a minimum. See below; green area indicates acceptable, red indicates prohibited area.
