**LRRS Supermoto Supplemental Rules**

The rules expressed below are the supplemental rules for the Loudon Road Race Series Supermoto event. The Loudon Road Race Series Rulebook is to be referenced for any rules not listed below

**Class Displacement Rules**

Supermini Class Rules

- 2 stroke, single-cylinder, 85cc – 112cc
- 4 stroke single-cylinder, 100cc – 150cc
- Unlimited modifications except the frame must remain a mini chassis

Lites Class Rules

- 2 stroke single-cylinder, 125cc – 144cc
- 4 stroke single-cylinder, 200cc – 250cc

Open Class Rules

- Single-cylinder, 250cc – open
- Twin-cylinder, 250cc – 575cc

**Schedule**

- Friday: Practice – 2 rounds Lites, Supermini, Open (7 minutes per class)
- Qualifying – Lites, Supermini, Open (7 minutes per class)
- Races are as follows: Lites – 12 minutes + 1 lap
- Supermini – 8 minutes + 1 lap
- Open – 12 minutes + 1 lap

**Licensing**

License from recognized organizations will be accepted. The following organizations will be recognized:  
AMA Supermoto, CCS/ASRA, LRRS, NEMM, NJ Mini Moto, SMEC

## **Timing and Scoring**

The primary scoring method will be electronic, using MyLaps (formerly AMB transponders)

All riders will be required to have their own MyLaps Tranx 260 compatible or X2 transponders, either self-powered or hard-wired to the machine electrical system

Rental units will be available

The rider will be required to pay the full replacement \$480 (retail) value of any transponder they do not return by the end of the event or within seven (7) days post event

The rider will be required to pay the full replacement \$480 (retail) value of any transponder they have done damage to, whether accidental or purposely

The rider is responsible for checking rented transponders for any damage prior to leaving registration

## **Technical Requirements**

### **Engine Coolant Regulations**

Liquid cooled engines and their radiators must be flushed. Only water or an approved ethylene and propylene glycol free cooling system additive may be used. The use of anti-freeze is subject to a \$50 fine. A list of approved additives is below and available at Tech Inspection. Additives not listed can be tested for legality in Tech Inspection.

### **Fluid Containment:**

Oil filler caps, drain plugs and oil lines must be safety wired

Oil filter bolts must be secured with safety wire

Spin-on oil filters must be secured with metal clamps and safety wire

All machines must have a catch device attached that has the carburetor and radiator overflow/vent lines running into it

The crankcase breather lines must have a catch device unless the lines are vented to the air box

### **Forks:**

Fork stops must be installed of sufficient size and strength to prevent fork tubes from contacting the fuel tank in a crash

**Lights:** The following must be taped over or removed. Clear tape is not permitted

Headlight

Taillight

Turn signals

### **Number Display Regulations**

All machines must have 3 sets of numbers. Numbers must be a minimum of 6" high

### **Safety Wire:**

All brake stay bolts and caliper mounting bolts must be lock wired

Axles must be secured by lock wiring both the axle and the nut or by a cotter pin through both the axle and the nut. Axle caps securing the front axle to the fork must be lock wired

Control levers and handlebars must be securely mounted

Throttles must snap back to the "off" position. Brake and clutch levers must have ball ends

**Tires:** Must be in good condition. Permitted in competition must meet the following criteria (unless otherwise specified by class requirements):

Roadrace slicks

Cut roadrace slicks  
Roadrace rain tires  
Class C dirt track tires  
Any DOT tire excluding DOT knobby tires
