WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE MOTOR SPEEDWAY

Dear camper,

Thank you for choosing New Hampshire Motor Speedway as your home-away-from-home for New England's only NASCAR weekend. Our team is focused on making this year's NASCAR weekend the best one yet, and we are thrilled to welcome you as we wave the green flag to summer, June 21-23.

The on-track action starts Friday, June 21 at "The Magic Mile" with practice and qualifying for the NASCAR Xfinity Series and Whelen Modified Tour before shifting gears to The Flat Track for SIG SAUER Academy Dirt Duels featuring Sprint Cars of New England, two classes of Granite State Mini Sprints and the Extreme Dirt Midget Association. Doubleheader Saturday, June 22 will kick off with practice and qualifying for the NASCAR Cup Series followed by the SciAps 200 NASCAR Xfinity Series race and Mohegan Sun 100 NASCAR Whelen Modified Tour race. The racing culminates on Sunday, June 23 as the NASCAR Cup Series takes the stage for the USA TODAY 301.

We've also got a jam-packed schedule of off-track entertainment including concerts, fireworks, live performances, driver appearances, charity events and the Fan Zone where you can find The Groove fan hangout, kids' activities and more starting Wednesday.

Campgrounds will open at 8 a.m. Saturday, June 15 and close at 12 p.m. Monday, June 24. Campers arriving between 10 p.m. – 8 a.m. will be staged overnight in the S11 Camper Check-In Lot. *Note: We are unable to stage or park campers/RVs on NHMS property prior to 8 a.m. Saturday, June 15.

Upon arrival to NHMS's South Entrance, please visit our camping trailer in the S11 Camper Check-In Lot to pick up your camping passes. There will be a very limited amount of water available at check-in (additional fee), so we encourage you to arrive with a full water tank. Feel free to visit our camping trailer any time during race week with any questions. See the map in this Camping Guide for the location of ice and parking at the Bath/Shower House.

Our goal is to give every guest the best experience possible during their time at NHMS, so here are some important reminders:

- The use of e-scooters, e-bikes or non-registered vehicles of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- Generators 75 decibels and below are able to run 24 hours/day. Units louder than 75 decibels will need to be shut off during quiet hours, no exceptions.
- Be courteous to your neighbors and refrain from loud parties, rowdiness, rude and immoral conduct and reckless driving.
- The possession of weapons, fireworks and explosives is strictly prohibited.
- Violators of any of these rules will be removed from the grounds and/or prosecuted without refund, no
 exceptions.



Campers will NOT be able to park between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. Campers that arrive between these hours will be staged in the S11 Lot. However, lots will be open to car traffic 24 hours/day.

All camping lots have reserved spaces. This space is for RV/campers, including slide-outs, awnings, tables and tow vehicles. If your camper is too large for your site, you will be required to move and incur any additional fees associated with the relocation.

All RVs and campers must be self-contained. A self-contained RV or camper must have on-board sanitary facilities and water. The speedway does not have hook-ups (with the exception of Turn Three and Trackside Terrace) or dumping facilities.

All drivers and their guests must have race day tickets in their possession before driving onto NHMS property. Anyone without race day tickets will not be allowed onto NHMS property.

The dumping of gray water and waste on speedway property is prohibited. Violation of this rule will result in arrest, fines and forfeiture of ticket renewal privileges.





NHMS has convenient handicapped parking for RVs, campers, and cars. We require all vehicles to have a state-issued handicapped plate or a stateissued handicapped placard hanging from the rearview mirror to park in a handicapped space. NHMS reserves the right refuse handicapped parking to those vehicles that do not contain a plate or placard.

If you choose to have a sleeping tent on your site, there is a limit of one tent per site per camper.



Hitches must face outward or be accessible for quick trailer removal.

All vehicles must have a tow vehicle sticker to park with their RV or camper. Any additional overnight vehicles will be parked in an overflow lot away from the campground. Any vehicles parked in fire lanes are subject to towing.

Pets must be on a leash at all times. Please be considerate of all guests and clean up after them. Pets are not allowed in the grandstands.

The following items are not permitted on NHMS property: private golf carts, unregistered motorcycles, mopeds, scooters, Segways, hoverboards, ATVs, weapons, fireworks, confederate flags, skateboards, rollerblades, human transporters, drones, scaffolding, electric scooters and electric bikes.





PARKING TYPES



RV CAMPING OPEN FIRE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Small cooking fires may be allowed only when the Forest Fire Warden deems conditions are safe. No cooking fire should be left unattended and should be put out with water before leaving the RV area. Cooking fires should be fueled with clean wood only. If you are caught burning materials other than clean wood, you will lose your rights to renew your race tickets.
- Bringing untreated out-of-state firewood into New Hampshire can spread damaging insects and diseases that threaten the health of our forests. A quarantine banning the entry of untreated out-of-state firewood into the state has been established by the N.H. Department of Resources and Economic Development and the N.H. Department of Agriculture, Markets & Food.



CARBON MONOXIDE WARNING

Carbon Monoxide (CO) poisoning is possible with camping equipment. CO is a poisonous gas that you cannot see or smell, but fumes can be harmful or fatal. Follow equipment instructions and if your equipment detects carbon monoxide, remove yourself from the area and notify us at (603) 513-5798.

Please ensure that your camper has a working CO detector device installed!



Carbon monoxide (CO) is an odorless, colorless gas that kills without warning. It claims the lives of hundreds of people every year and makes thousands more ill. Many household items including gas-and oil-burning furnaces, portable generators, and charcoal grills produce this poison gas. Following these important steps can keep your family safe.

CO DETECTORS

- Install battery-operated or battery back-up CO detectors near every sleeping area in your home.
- Check CO detectors regularly to be sure they are functioning properly.

OIL & GAS FURNACES

• Have your furnace inspected every year.

PORTABLE GENERATORS

- Never use a generator inside your home or garage, even if doors and windows are open.
- Only use generators outside, more than 20 feet away from your home, doors, and windows.




